

OUTPATIENT CLINICAL THERAPIST (LMSW/LCSW, LAC/LPC, OR LPE)

This exempt position works under administrative supervision of the Division Director. Performs psychotherapy or other appropriate clinical services in the treatment of clientele.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Interview/assess clients; performs individual, family and group psychotherapy as appropriate in the treatment of clients;
- Participate in the development and implementation of treatment plans; i.e. PCA's and Managed Care.
- Perform psychological evaluations and assessments (LPE only)
- Compile, maintain and review clinical case records in compliance with PCA's guidelines. All paperwork meets PCA's timelines and policies.
- Participates in the PCA Emergency Services On-Call rotation or in the Emergency Screening rotation

NON-ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Provide mental health consultation, education, and public relations services.
- Perform other duties as assigned

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Thorough knowledge of psychological theories and principles of behavior
- Knowledge of professional methods and techniques of psychotherapy
- Knowledge of psychological tests and procedures (LPE only)
- Ability to make routine professional and administrative decisions
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with clients, staff and the public

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- Must be qualified mental health professional as defined by State Standards. Past experience in mental health and utilization of community resources is preferred.
- Must have one of the following credentials:
- Masters Degree in Social Work and licensed by the state of Arkansas; or
- Masters Degree and licensed by the state of Arkansas as a Psychological Examiner; or
- Masters Degree and licensed as a LAC or LPC by the state of Arkansas.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- A criminal background check may be required at supervisor's discretion.
