

PSYCHIATRIST

This exempt position works under the administrative supervision of the Division Director; provides psychopharmacology, consultation services to Professional Counseling Associates clinical staff and other appropriate clinical services in the treatment of clientele.

RESPONSIBILITIES

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Performs psychiatric evaluations, assessing mental disorders and recommendation for treatment
- Prescribes and/or administers medication
- Provides consultative services to clinical staff, including review and evaluating treatment plans, provides medical information relevant to the development of the treatment plan
- Complete all required paperwork for Managed Care and Medicaid requirements.
- May provide in-patient services
- Participates in the PCA Emergency Services On-Call rotation or in the Emergency Screening rotation

NON-ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Provides emergency and medical back-up services to clinical staff during and after office hours
- Performs other duties as assigned

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Thorough knowledge of the principles and skill in the practice of psychiatry
- Ability to make professional decisions
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with clients, staff and public

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:

- Licensed physician
- Completion of residency in psychiatry or, with the approval of the Medical Director, enrollment in psychiatry residency or relevant experience

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- A criminal background check may be required at supervisor's discretion.
