

AMBULATORY CARE PARAPROFESSIONAL

This non-exempt position works under the direction and administrative supervision of the Assistant Director CSP/Day Services. Specific assignments, daily direction and clinical supervision are received from the Mental Health Professional (CSP Primary Therapist) to whom they are assigned. In tandem they address the needs of an exceptionally high caseload of CSP clients. This position may have primary responsibility for some clients on the caseload and only specific tasks to perform with other clients. As a team and in conjunction with the assigned Psychiatrist this paraprofessional and the CSP Primary Therapist will address the needs of the clients assigned to the therapist.

Requirements:

- Applicant must have a Bachelor's Degree (preferably in Social Work or Psychology) in a human service field and certified or eligible for certification as a mental health paraprofessional as defined by State Standards, or have an Arkansas license as a nurse (i.e., LPTN or LPN) and certified or eligible for certification as a mental health paraprofessional as defined by State Standards.
- Must have current Arkansas Driver's License and a good driving record.
- CPR and First Aid certification
- Criminal background check
- Experience in mental health is preferred.
- Computer skills a plus
